Deb and Gary Slade: Deb and Gary Slade of County Road 12 in the Town of Andover were present to voice their concerns about the excessive speed and passing where County Road 12 begins, just of State Route 417. The Slade's state that they have seen many accidents and near misses over the years and the situation is getting worse. They are requesting the Town look into have the passing zone changed to a no passing zone. They have petitioned the neighbors and they are in agreement. Supervisor Weber recommended that the Slade's send the petition to the County, as they oversee the speed and passing zones. However, the Town can request a study by done by the County.
